Plus, a bonus reveal has been built in, to give you an alternative ending for table-hopping or walkaround situations or as an extra kicker. This is a pocket-sized book that packs a huge punch! It can be performed in close-up, parlor or on stage - ideal for almost any performing conditions! Multiple principles at play make this effortless to use and a joy for the performer. If you can remember three, simple things you can perform this immediately.

Triadic - Three reveals, super-easy to perform and a hit every time with no fishing whatsoever for letters, clues or page numbers and the spectator holds the book throughout - you are nowhere near them.
