

Boston Box Natural

EFFECT 1 - The magician puts one or more coins into the Box and closes it with the lid. He places it on the back of his hand and then taps the lid. Magically the coins fall on the table penetrating the Box and the magician's hand. The Box will be empty!

EFFECT 2 - The magician puts one or more coins into the Box and closes it with the lid. He puts it on the table and puts one of his hands under the table. Magically the coins penetrate the Box and the table, ending up in the hand of the magician. The Box will be empty!

The routines above are an example of the potential of this box. There are many other presentations, ideas, techniques, etc. that can be easily found in magic books and videos.

The Boston box is a particular variant of the Okito box and allows, compared to the latter, to be able to show the "coins" still in the box until a moment before they penetrate the table or the back of the hand.

- Carefully crafted from fine wood.
- With this fantastic accessory you can present easy or complex routines, all based on your own skill level.
- Used coins, not supplied, must have a diameter a few tenths of a millimeter less than the box. The American half dollar coins are perfect.
