Without any suspicious moves, you take the final envelope and open it to reveal \$100. Not only that, but it's \$100 in multiple bills that are NOT folded or wrinkled in any way. Everything can be seen being pulled directly from the envelope. There's very clearly no thumb tips or body loads in play.

NOTE: A couple dabs of restickable glue will need to be applied to the gimmick. Both John and Vanishing Inc. recommend Zig 2 Way Glue, which is readily available online and many other stores.
